Scripture

- **Romans 5:8. 17-21**

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.

For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

The high priest carries the blood of animals into the Most Holy Place as a sin offering, but the bodies are burned outside the camp. And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate, to sanctify [and make holy] the people by His own blood.

If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own, but because you are not of the world, because I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

Main Points

- Through the blood of the Lamb:
 - We have redemption.
 - We are justified.
 - We have sanctification.
 - We have been quickened.
- Justification is being acquitted-declared not guilty, released from any criminal charge.
- We are holy and blameless through Yeshua by the blood of the lamb.
- Believe that it's already done and stand against the lie!
- HOW TO SEIZE THE WORD OF GOD
 - Study the WORD of GOD
 - Know that Jesus (the Word) lives in You.
- The Word of God is more than just the written Bible. The Word of God is Jesus Himself.
- The Hebrew word Kavanah in English means "directing one's heart".
- Holy means to be set apart; to be cutout; unique
