Main Points

- God speaks to us powerfully also through **prophecy, dreams, and visions.**
- One of the most common ways in Scripture that God speaks to His people is through their dreams at night.
- God is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
- A dream is when God comes to us in our sleep and uses imagery, such as circumstances and relationships, to communicate His will for our lives.
- English word dream in Hebrew is Chalom
- A dream is sometimes called in Scripture a “vision of the night.”
- A vision appeared to Paul in the night...(Acts 16:9)
