

Prophetic Fulfillment of God's Fall Holy Days: How to Apply the Blood of Jesus



Scriptures

- **Leviticus 17:11**

“For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement.”

- **Hebrews 9:11-12, 25-26**

But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things to come, He entered through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands-- that is to say, not of this creation; and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

...nor was it that He would offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the holy place year by year with blood that is not his own. Otherwise, He would have needed to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now once at the consummation of the ages He has been manifested to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.

- **Revelation 12:11**

“And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.”

- **Exodus 12:21-23**

Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel and said to them, “Go and take for yourselves lambs according to your families and slay the Passover lamb. You shall take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood which is in the basin and apply some of the blood that is in the basin to the lintel and the two doorposts; and none of you shall go outside the door of his house until morning. For the LORD will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the LORD will pass over the door and will not allow the destroyer to come in to your houses to smite you.

Main Points

Yom Kippur-The Day of Atonement

- God's Holy Days teach us about His redemptive plan.
- Jesus completed the ceremony of Yom Kippur by offering Himself.
- Because of Jesus' sacrifice, we now have access to God.
- The sacrifice of Jesus does not mean that everyone has automatically been forgiven.
- Three Principles for Overcoming
 - The Blood of the Lamb
 - Testimony
 - Sold-Out Life to God
- In order for Jesus' death to save us, we must apply it to our lives.
- We apply the blood of Jesus to our lives through the word of our testimony.
- Jesus didn't die just to forgive us, He died to make us His bride.
- Father God, Lord Jesus, thank you Jesus for purchasing me by Your blood. Thank you for redeeming me. I love you. I give my heart to you. Father I declare I have been redeemed. I've been purchased by Your Son, the precious Lamb of God.
