Scripture

- **2 Samuel 5:17-20**

When the Philistines heard that they had anointed David king over Israel, all the Philistines went up to seek out David; and when David heard of it, he went down to the stronghold. Now the Philistines came and spread themselves out in the valley of Rephaim. Then David inquired of the LORD, saying, "Shall I go up against the Philistines? Will You give them into my hand?" And the LORD said to David, "Go up, for I will certainly give the Philistines into your hand." So David came to Baal-Perazim and defeated them there; and he said, "The LORD has broken through my enemies before me like the breakthrough of waters."

Main Points

- We have the ultimate purpose: We have been called into a relationship with the Living God!

- We need to learn how to walk through spiritual battles when they happen.
- The first thing we should do when under attack is get alone with God.

- Your weakness is being transformed into divine strength.
- You are being transformed and will come through this victorious!
- The breakthrough that you will experience by your hand is because the Spirit of God is breaking through you!
