Main Points

- The enemy is able to project a spiritual construct into our minds.
- We must stay in connection with God to receive what He wants to deposit into us.
- We must face the fears, the anxieties, and the challenges head on in the Lord and go through them.
- The enemy motivates us for a desire for pleasure or deceives us with belief that we can escape the pain.
- Rather than looking for the Lord *there*, we need to be grounded and look for the Lord **here**.
- It's not *then* and *there*, it's **here** and **now**.
- If we are going to walk in the power of God, it's got to be in the **here** and **now**!
- Yeshua is found in the depths, not in the shallows.
- You have a will.
- Know that you're in a battle.
- We can walk on water, every single day by choosing our thoughts rightly.

Discussion Questions

1. How does the enemy keep us in bondage in our mind?
2. What is the remedy for dealing with the thoughts the enemy constantly tries to inject into our thinking, even as He did with Jesus?
3. Is the peace, power, and joy that God has for us found then and there, or here and now? What does this mean? As you apply this to your own life, what are you looking to that are substitutes for looking into God's face for instruction and comfort?
4. If our goal is to see Jesus, where will we find him? In 2 Corinthians 1:8-9 Paul wrote that our weakness provides us opportunity to do deeper with God. How does this turn around your thoughts on the challenges God brings to you?
5. What is the choice before you as concerns your thinking? What is the choice you will make today?
6. The battle is a battle of your will. Are you ready to walk on water with Jesus? If we refuse to trust God, we seal ourselves off to death and isolation. Write about this. Talk to God about this.
