Scripture

- John 11:41-42

So they removed the stone. Then Jesus raised His eyes, and said, “Father, I thank You that You have heard Me. I knew that You always hear Me; but because of the people standing around I said it, so that they may believe that You sent Me.”

- John 12:27-28

Now My soul has become troubled; and what shall I say, ‘Father, save Me from this hour’? But for this purpose I came to this hour.

Father glorify Your name.” Then a voice came out of heaven: “I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again.”

Main Points

- When we look into the prayer life of Jesus, we see what eternal life looks like.
- The primary quality of eternal life is relationship.
- It is powerful to speak God’s Word out loud.
- God wants you to be assured that He hears the subtle whispers of your heart.
- God hears you always!
- Wherever you go in the future, God will be with you!
- Understanding the words in Jesus’ prayer life will bring us into greater intimacy with God.
- When you open your heart to the Father, He is speaking back to you.
- God wants you to share your life with Him.
- We let God into our lives by talking to Him.
- God hears your heart and He’s responding to you.

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Discussion Questions

1. What is the primary quality of eternal life?
2. What are some principles Rabbi shared about God's being able to hear us?
3. What are some things that the Holy Spirit has pinpointed for your heart in today's study? Write about steps you need to take to be obedient to Him.
4. If God is not in your mind's projections of future events, what does that mean for how you should ask God to help you think about the future? What are some statements and principles from God's Word that speak to this? How can this alleviate fear and worry from your life?
5. Is sharing your life with God difficult for you? Begin your ongoing conversation today about everything that crosses your thinking today. Does knowledge that He hears even the whispers of your heart help you to do this more completely?
6. Is greater intimacy something you would like to have with God? How can this be achieved?
