

# The Meaning of Each Color of the Rainbow

## Scripture

- **Exodus 28:2--6**

You shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother, for glory and for beauty...to consecrate him, that he may minister as priest to Me.

These are the garments which they shall make; a breast piece and an ephod and a robe and a tunic of checkered work, a turban and a sash, and they shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother and his sons, that he may minister as priest to Me. They shall take the gold and the **blue** and the **purple** and the **scarlet** material and the fine linen. They shall also make the ephod of gold, of **blue** and **purple** and **scarlet** material and fine twisted linen, the work of the skillful workman.

- **Jeremiah 2:13**

For My people have committed two evils: They have forsaken Me, the Fountain of living waters, to hew for themselves cisterns. Broken cisterns that can hold no water.

- **John 7:38**

“He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, ‘From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.’”

## Main Points

- Colors have a spiritual meaning. They communicate relationship.
- Colors are living and will be experienced in heaven. A rainbow surrounds God's throne.
- Red is one of the three primary colors. Adam is literally “son of the red earth”.
- It speak intensity. The symbol of fiery, jealous, passionate love.
- Orange is a combination of red and yellow. It conveys positive, social connections between people.
- Yellow conveys optimism, confidence, and an expectation of a happy future.
- Green is a nurturing and peaceful color that conveys newness of life.
- Blue conveys heaven and how God is always above us. It is the color of divinity.
- The Ark of the Covenant: Numbers 4:5-6
- All the Articles used for service in Tabernacle: Numbers 4:12

- Indigo conveys an anointing of inner awareness, intuition, and wisdom to execute a vision.
- Purple is the color of man's glory and a symbol of wealth.
